

Free E-Books

To successfully download free e-books you will need to go through a multi-step process. Often they can be read directly on a computer but for best results use an e-reader. Probably there are a few different ways of doing this but it is recommended that you get the free e-book management application Calibre (<https://calibre-ebook.com/>). Calibre allows you to store, in an organized manner all your e-books. It also enables you to transform formats such as .txt, .pdf, .epub, .mobi into one another so you can convert a .pdf into a .epub for an e-reader [including kindle format] or a .mobi for a mobile phone.

The workflow would be as follows -

[Find download → load to Calibre → (possibly convert to e-readable file) → then upload to an e-reader].

Caution: numerous sites offer links to 'indie' or self-published books; some will be great, and many are less than good. Do choose your reading material carefully, sometimes there is a very good reason why books do not attract a publisher!

- Bookboon is currently the world's largest online publishing company of eBooks. In 2015 over 50 million eBooks were downloaded from the site. It is focused on publishing student literature for engineering, IT and business students as well as short and practical business books. Bookboon has over 900 academic textbooks freely available to students on their website that are written by academics and are financed by employer branding ads which are placed in the books.

[BookGuru](#)

- BookGuru is a website that allows users to download eBooks for free. The site contains PDF files of college textbooks, self-help books, guidebooks, and novels. Users can search through the digital library by title or by ISBN.

[Classic Literature Library](#)

- Read some of the best classic literature books ever published completely free. From Shakespeare's Sonnets to Jane Austen's classic romance novels, all for free. Over 400 classic books and novels you can read free online. The library includes the greatest books of all time, including; Moby Dick, The Call of the Wild, . . . etc.

ManyBooks	- ManyBooks is a site that's been around for over a decade. Its purpose is to curate and provide a library of free and discounted fiction e-books. Much of its collection was seeded by Project Gutenberg back in the mid-2000s but has since taken on an identity of its own with the addition of thousands of self-published works that have been made available at no charge. Downloads are available in dozens of formats, including EPUB, MOBI, and PDF, and each story has a Flesch-Kincaid score to show how easy or difficult it is to read.
Open Culture	- Download 800 free eBooks to your Kindle, iPad/iPhone, computer, smart phone or e-reader. Collection includes great works of fiction, non-fiction and poetry, including works by Asimov, Jane Austen, Philip K. Dick, F. Scott Fitzgerald, Neil Gaiman, Tolstoy, Dostoevsky, Shakespeare, Ernest Hemingway, Virginia Woolf & James Joyce.
pdfBooksWorld	- It has one of the largest collections of high-quality free PDF eBooks. All eBooks in PDF Books World are stored in their server itself, which means you are not going to download eBooks from an external website link. To download any eBook from PDF Books World, you should have account and its free. PDF Books World website contents are categories into fictions, novels, academic and juvenile sections.
Planetebook.net	- Planet eBook is a website that offers a wide range of classic literature books in different formats like ePub, MOBI, and PDF. All titles are free to download. Classic great reads from great authors.
The Internet Archive	- The Internet Archive offers over 15,000,000 freely downloadable books and texts. There is also a collection of 550,000 modern eBooks that may be borrowed by anyone with a free archive.org account.
The Literature Network	- The Literature Network: This site is organized alphabetically by author. Click on any author's name, and you'll see a biography, related links and articles, quizzes, and forums. Most of the books here are free, but there are some downloads that require a small fee.

Wikibooks.org	- Wikibooks is a wiki-based Wikimedia project hosted by the Wikimedia Foundation for the creation of free content e-book textbooks and annotated texts that anyone can edit.
